- 3 Loch Tay circular route (48 miles) fantastic scenic route around Perthshire's largest loch with plenty of places to stop for food, shopping, history and views.
- 4 Glenlyon Circular route (60 miles) Travel into Scotland's longest glen and the area's best kept secret. Towering mountains, ancient forests and stunning views abound around every corner. Don't forget to stop for homemade soups, cakes and scones.
- 5 Loch Rannoch circular. (70 miles) Wild and rugged route around Loch Rannoch and the most isolated railway station in the UK with the option to jump on a train to Fort William and the steam train to Mallaig.
